Brand New Uniform Policy

Your Parent Association was asked by the school to get involved in talking about our uniform. Based on parents' feedback we have:

- Found a new supplier (O'Farrells)
 providing cost savings on all
 uniform items. For additional
 convenience, we have kept
 Kidstuff as alternative suppliers.
- Reduced the number of school specific uniform items with generic, plain coloured uniforms and from this September sew on crests will be available to reduce costs even further.
- Run second hand uniform sales to reduce uniform costs on parents.
- Asked for clear guidance on the school uniform in a separate policy distinct from the Code of Behaviour.
- Researched the uniform policies of over 30 primary schools across the country and sought advice from Barnardos and the NPC (National Parents Council)

Please let us know if there is anything else you would like us to raise on your behalf. The new policy is due to be distributed by the school.
