Congratulations to **Oisín Molloy** on the publication of his own book, that he also illustrated – A Leprechaun Adventure. We are so proud of his work.


Unexplained Absences

If your child is collected from school early or by someone different, please notify the class teacher in advance. Pupils leaving early must be signed out at reception. Parents must give a reason for the child's absence. This is kept for school records and must be given to Túsla if the child exceeds 20 days absence in a school year.

All absences from school must be explained by parents by email or by a note to the class teacher. You can input the reason on Aladdin which must be approved by the Principal.

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If your child has symptoms that require <u>Calpol or Neurofen</u>, your child should not attend school.

Allergies

As a number of children in our school suffer from allergies, nuts or products/foods containing nuts e.g. Nutella are not permitted in school.

Foods containing raw eggs e.g. mayonnaise or coleslaw are not permitted in school as we have children allergic to eggs in school.
