

Please remember the following:


- Please ensure your child is on time for school (8.40-8.55am) so that they may enter through the correct gate/door. Class contact time starts at 8.55am
- Parents are asked to drop their children and leave the school area to keep this area free of
 congestion. Please do not congregate at the front of the school or block the footpath. The
 two evening dispersal times are in place to eliminate congestion at the front of the school.
 All parents are asked to drop and go and collect and go. All adults asked to wear masks when
 dropping off or collecting children.
- Children should bring lunch, drinks and equipment to school. We ask parents only to drop items to the office in an emergency. This should not become a habit.
- All children need to bring a hand cloth in a ziplock bag to school. These should be changed daily.
- As winter comes in and temperatures drop, we usually experience an increase of sickness among children. Please do not send your child to school if he/she is sick.
- We must keep windows open in all classrooms to aid ventilation in classrooms. The heat is
 on but school may still feel cooler than normal. Your child may wish to wear an additional
 layer under his/her uniform.
