Family tree

Today you will be making a personalised family tree



Equipment Needed

1. Small leaves collected from outside
2. Paper
3. Colouring pencils
4. Marker/ pen



Step 1

- Go outside and search for small clean, dry leaves
- Any shape , colour, make sure they aren't too big for the page



Step 2

- Once you have your leaves go inside and get a piece of paper can be any colour
- Draw a tree trunk on your page this the one in this image
- Each layer on the branch is for a different generation of your family
- Bottom layer being you and your siblings followed by your mother and father followed by grandparents



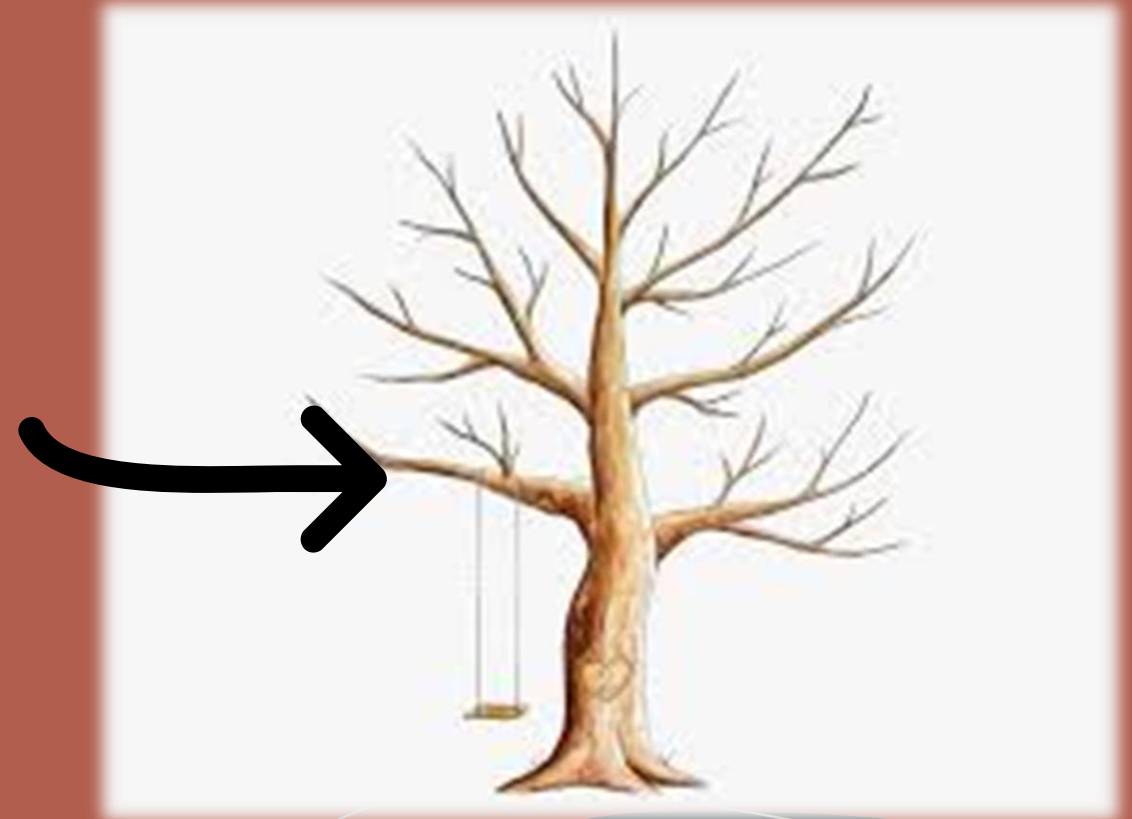
Step 3

- Once you have your tree trunk drawn, you can begin to create your family tree
- Ask your parent for help if you need
- You will need to know your siblings names, mother and fathers names, and grandparents from both your mother and father sides names



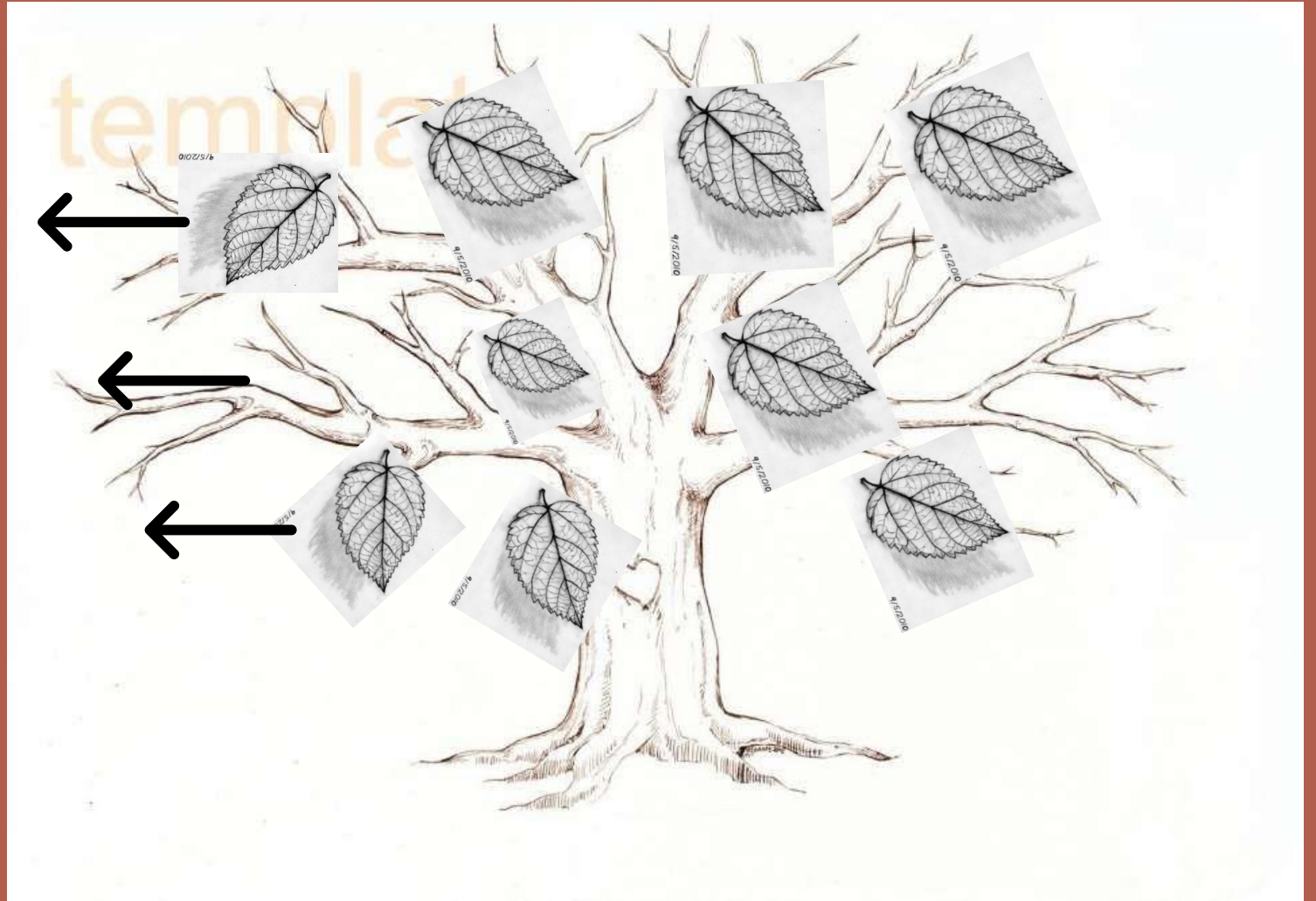
Step 4

- Starting at the bottom layer of the branch of your tree trunk
- Trace your leaves onto the tree trunk
- Place the leaves under the place and use a colouring pencil to sketch over them
- The bottom leaves should be your siblings and you
- For example if you have two siblings you should have 3 leaves at the bottom including yourself



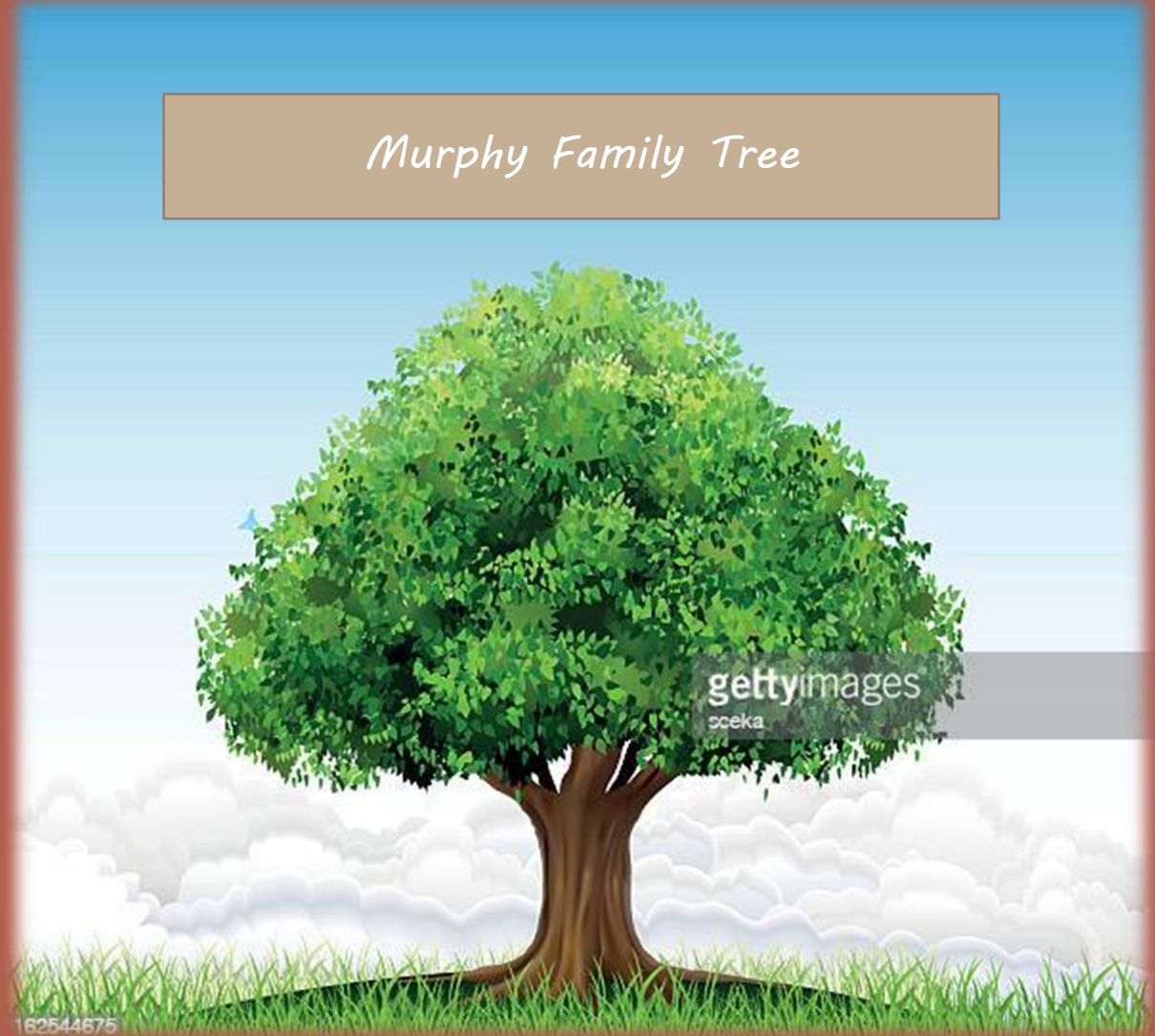
Step 5

- Repeat this through out your family tree next with your parents
- Followed by your grand parents



Final step

- Write in the names of each of the family members on top of the traced leaves
- In the background of your tree make sure you decorate it by including grass and the sky
- Make sure to add your family name to the top of the tree
