

#### COVID-19

It is great to see the country beginning to open up and children getting back to some outdoor activities. Please remember we must remain vigilant in school to ensure we have no outbreaks and can stay open. Your child should not attend school if they have:

- a temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or more
- any other common symptoms of COVID-19 a new cough, loss or changed sense of taste or smell, shortness of breath or an existing breathing condition that has recently become worse
- been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
- been living with someone who is unwell and may have COVID-19
- other uncommon symptoms of COVID-19, such as sore throat or headaches
- diarrhoea
- returned from another country in the last 14 days

Please continue to wear a mask at the front of the school and drop off/ collect promptly. Thank you for your support with this.




