

HSE hearing screening consent forms were sent home last week with students from Junior and Senior Infants. Please return completed forms at your earliest convenience.


Parent teacher meetings are pencilled in for the **16th/17th of November**. They will be through phone calls, as they were last year. Links were sent out to parents last week to book times.


