### Covid 19 Update

Please continue to follow all public safety advice and do not send your child to school if they are ill or have symptoms. The department are hoping to roll out new guidance by the 29<sup>th</sup> November. In a nutshell if a child tests positive a parent is advised to let the principal know. The principal can then inform the child's pod there is a confirmed case and the parents can apply for antigen tests if they want. The children in the pod can still come to school while undertaking 3 antigen tests (1 every second day). If any are positive they are advised to go for a test. If there is a second case outside of the pod the whole class will be offered antigen tests. Reminder that if someone in your house tests positive, everyone in the house is required to restrict their movements.
