

The Anti Bullying Committee is holding The Saint Patrick's Day Colouring Art Competition. Please see attached for details.


Playball – today is the last day of Term 2. A new term will be starting next Monday 13th of March. If anyone would be interested in joining, please see https://www.playballkids.com.
