

A reminder that the Parent Nominee for the Board of Management is to be returned to the school office no later than Wednesday the 8th November for any parent wishing to be considered.



RNS Bric-a-Brac Collection

On Tuesday and Wednesday 28th and 29th of November 2023 RNS will hold their annual Bric-A-Brac sale in aid of Sightsavers. In January 2024, our Fifth-Class teacher Ms. Kirstin Conroy is taking part in Sightsavers First Light for Sight Sunrise Challenge and is travelling to the Arctic Circle with 20 Irish volunteers to fundraise for Sightsavers. In the Arctic she will be learning Arctic survival skills and will partake in a 36-hour trek and camp in minus 20 to minus 25 degrees to reach to a remote cabin, and survive with no running water, no electricity and only the food they have carried. This challenge will test her limits but she hopes the gruelling nature of the challenge will allow her to reach her fundraising aim and **money raised from the Bric-a-Brac collection will go towards providing at least 156 sight restoring operations.** In order to contribute to this wonderful cause Ms. Conroy is gathering bric-a-brac items such as toys, unwanted small items, pictures, jewellery, teddies, ornaments, books etc which can be sent in and left at the office.
