### **Pathfinder Retrofit Programme**

Yesterday, Minister Helen McEntee confirmed that our school would be participating in the EU Pathfinder Retrofit Programme. This has been a lengthy process, with only 28 being chosen nationally for the project. The deep retrofit will involve installing heat pumps, LED and mechanical heat recovery lighting ventilation. The fabric and airtightness of the school will also be upgraded and electric car chargers will be installed. These upgrades will greatly enhance comfort and functionality in the school while contributing to a lower carbon footprint and reduced energy costs. It will hopefully have a transformative effect on our school. Building works will take place during the summer months. We will reopen as planned on 28th August.
